- ✂ Prune and repair winter damage
- ✂ Remove winter mulch and all other protective coverings
- ✂ Schedule tree and shrub fertilization
- ✂ Cut back ornamental grasses before new growth appears



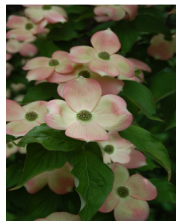
Plant Spotlight: Nandina...



...is an ornamental plant that is beautiful year-round. Young leaves are pink or red before turning green.

Early summer flowers are white. Bright red berries ripen in late autumn and often last through the winter. Easy to care for, Nandina needs no pruning unless it is to harvest leaves for a flower arrangement or berries for a holiday centerpiece. Rabbits and deer won't eat this plant, but leave the berries on the plants for birds to harvest in late winter.
